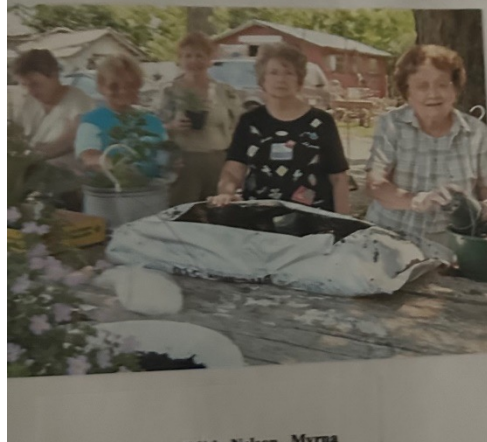


STATE GARDEN CLUB MEETING APRIL 2007

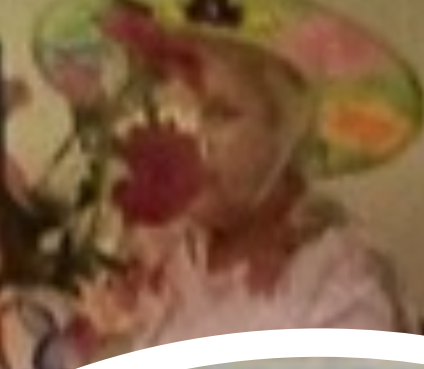

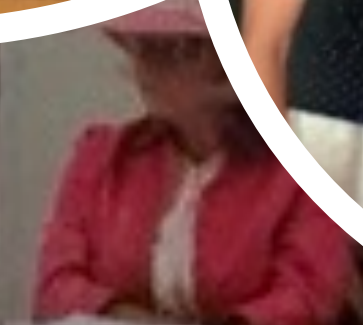
